

# Keeping HUSKY A for your family

You need to renew your HUSKY health coverage once a year. You will probably be able to keep HUSKY

- even if your family has more money
- even if you have private insurance
- even if you don't get other benefits, such as cash assistance

## When you get your renewal form

- The renewal form has two parts. Part one is already filled out with what you put in your last application.
- Where the form shows "earnings" put your income even if it has not changed.
- Part two lets you add new changes, like a new family member or income from a new job.
- Sign both parts of the form even if there are no changes. Make a copy for yourself if you can.
- Mail in your form quickly.
- If you want other benefits like cash or food stamps, DSS may ask you to go to their office in person.

Many families with jobs or child support can keep HUSKY A for up to one extra year.

## If your income is too high for HUSKY A

Your children may be able to get HUSKY B (low cost health insurance).

### Remember:

- Fill out all forms and mail them back quickly
- If you change your address, let HUSKY know
